The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 378 dated 31.07.2017, under Sections 365, 341, 342, 379A, 395 IPC (Section 413 added later on), registered at Police Station Sadar Dadri, District Bhiwani, Haryana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations against the petitioner are that a stolen truck was recovered from him. He further contends that the petitioner has been in custody for over one month since the date of his arrest on 10.08.2017 and co-accused, namely, Sanjay has been granted regular bail by the Additional Sessions Judge on 06.09.2017. He further contends that the petitioner is not involved in any other case.

In view of the above submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner and the petitioner having been in custody for over one month, I deem it a fit case to grant concession of regular bail

to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner, namely, Anil Kumar is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
