KULDIP SINGH J. (ORAL)

Petitioner claims that he has been falsely implicated in NDPS case regarding recovery of opium. He has placed reliance upon his conversation with the police official. He has moved representation dated 08.09.2017 (Annexure P-5) to Harpreet Singh Sidhu IPS, A.D.G.P. (Punjab), Chandigarh, who is presently dealing with the NDPS cases.

At this stage, it is deemed proper that the police be directed to re-verify the facts as to whether the genuine recovery of opium was effected or it is a false case?

As such, the present petition is disposed of with direction to the A.D.G.P. (Punjab), Chandigarh to look into the representation of the petitioner dated 08.09.2017 (Annexure P-5) and find out the truth in the allegations levelled therein. The same shall be done expeditiously before presentation of challan.
