Petitioners prayed for grant of anticipatory bail in a complaint case in which they have been summoned under Section 506 IPC and Section 3(x) of the Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989.

There is a property dispute between Jarnail Singh and complainant Jasdeep Kaur in respect of a house. There was a Panchayat convened by Jarnail Singh for amicable resolution of dispute. Petitioners attended the Panchayat proceedings as witnesses. Two FIRs against the complainant were registered on the statement of Beant Kaur wife of Jarnail Singh i.e. FIR No.83 dated 19.03.2014 under Sections 452/323/427/506/148/149 IPC and FIR No.103 dated 06.04.2014 under Sections 420/34 IPC. The present complaint

has been filed against Beant Kaur wife of Jarnail Singh as well.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contended that the filing of the complaint is a result of counter-blast of the aforesaid FIRs, particularly when the alleged occurrence took place on 24.01.2014 and the present complaint came to be filed only in March, 2014.

At this stage, it has come on record that pursuant to order dated 19.10.2016, petitioners have already appeared before the trial Court and they have been released on interim bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

In view of aforesaid, order dated 19.10.2016 passed by this Court is made absolute. Petitioners will keep on appearing before the trial Court on each and every date.
