Learned counsel for the respondent-State, on instructions from S.I. Darshan Singh, contends that no representation dated 29.08.2017 (Annexure-P2) has ever been received in the office of Senior Superintendent of Police, Kapurthala, therefore, the instant petition has been filed on wrong facts. She further contends that an F.I.R. has been registered against the petitioner and two other persons with the allegation of usurping ₹70,00,000/- from respondent No.4 under the garb of providing a certificate of permanent residency at abroad.

On coming to know of these facts, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for withdrawal of the instant petition. The same is dismissed as withdrawn with costs of ₹10,000/- to be deposited in the Legal Services Authority, Kapurthala. The Secretary, Legal Services Authority, Kapurthala is directed to recover the costs from the petitioner.
