By filing the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioners have sought anticipatory bail in FIR No.84 dated 28.05.2009, registered under Section 420 of Indian Penal Code (in short 'IPC') at Police Station Mansa City, District Mansa.

On 25.10.2016, this Court had passed the following order:-

“Notice of motion.

At the asking of the Court, Ms. Harsimrat Rai, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State. A complete copy of the paper book has been furnished to the learned State counsel, in the Court.

At this stage, Mr. J.S.Khiva, Advocate causes representation on behalf of complainant.

Complainant is present in the Court. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that entire amount has been given towards the final settlement. Learned counsel of the complainant on instructions states that she will have no objection if the present petition is allowed.

In view of the above, it is ordered that in case the petitioners surrender before the trial Court within three weeks from today, they be admitted to bail subject to their furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned.

Post again on 16.12.2016.”

It is contended that in pursuance of the order dated 25.10.2016, petitioners have surrendered before the learned trial Court and furnished bail bonds.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 25.10.2016, is made absolute.

The petition stands allowed.
