Through this petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, prayer has been made for quashing cross case vide Diary No.31 dated 27.01.2013 under Sections 452, 324, 323, 506, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code (for short, 'IPC') in case F.I.R. No.21 dated 24.01.2013 registered under Sections 452, 325, 323, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code, at Police Station Jandiala Guru, Amritsar (Rural), on the basis of compromise dated 26.07.2017 (Annexure-P3).

On presentation of the petition, vide order dated 21.09.2017 passed by a co-ordinate Bench of this Court, the parties were directed to appear before the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate on 23.10.2017 for recording their statements qua compromise with a direction to the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate to furnish a report regarding veracity thereof, if any, between the

parties.

Consequently, the parties had appeared before the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Amritsar and got recorded their statements. Report from the concerned Magistrate has been received vide covering letter No.126 dated 03.11.2017 duly forwarded by learned District and Sessions Judge, Amritsar vide Endorsement No.10095-R dated 07.11.2017.

According to the report of Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Amritsar, the parties have made an amicable settlement and have recorded their statements in the court without any fear, pressure, threat or coercion and out of their free will.

In view of the totality of the facts and circumstances and considering the fact that the compromise will bring harmony in relations between the parties, the present petition is accepted and the aforesaid cross case vide Diary No.31 registered in F.I.R. No.21, is quashed qua the petitioners, subject to depositing costs of ₹10,000/- by the petitioners with the Punjab Legal Services Authority, Chandigarh within one week.

The Registry is directed to report whether the cost is deposited by the petitioners or not.
