The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail in FIR No.424 dated 02.08.2017 registered under Sections 323 and 326 IPC at Police Station City Narnaul, District Mohindergarh.

Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

The prosecution case is that while watching the cricket match a quarrel took place and in that the petitioner had thrown a plate towards the complainant who received injury on his left eye. The offence is triable by the Magistrate. The challan has already been filed before the concerned Court. The trial will take its own time.

Looking to the fact that the offences are triable by the Magistrate, no useful purpose will be served by continuing the detention

of the petitioner in jail pending trial. In that view of the matter, I make the following order:

ORDER

- (i) CRL. MISC. No.M-35503 OF 2017 is allowed.
- (ii) The petitioner be released on bail to the satisfaction of the concerned CJM/Duty Magistrate.
- (iii) The petitioner shall not enter the limits of Tehsil Narnaul, District Mohindergarh till the trial is completed and also shall not apply for modification of this condition.
- (iv) The petitioner shall report to the police station Sadar Narnaul on every Sunday from 11.00am to 4.00pm in addition to appearing before the trial Court on the dates fixed there.
- (v) The petitioner shall not tamper or influence the prosecution witness(es).
- (vi) The State will be at liberty to apply for cancellation of bail in case of violation of above condition.
