By filing the present petition, under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought anticipatory bail in FIR No.14 dated 30.01.2016, registered under Section 370 of IPC and Section 4 of Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, at Police Station Hathaur, District Ludhiana.

It is contended that the petitioner is a 60 year old lady and she has nothing to do with the present FIR. Co-accused, Rekha has already been released on regular bail.

Heard.

This is the 2nd bail petition filed on behalf of the petitioner. The first bail application was dismissed by passing a detailed order, by way of order dated 07.09.2016 (Annexure P-3).

The learned counsel for the petitioner has failed to point out any

fresh favorable circumstance in favour of the petitioner. Keeping in view the above, this Court is not inclined to accept the prayer made in the instant petition.
