2. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Avtar Singh Sandhu, Additional Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the State.

3. In this petition, the petitioner seeks for protection of his life and liberty with a view to ensure that no harassment is caused to him by respondent No. 3, who is the Local Police Officer, at the instance of the private respondent No. 4. He alleges that the Local Police Authorities have been unnecessarily harassing him by needlessly calling him to the Police Station, even though no actual case has been registered against him to his knowledge. In this connection, he submitted a representation to respondent No. 2 on 16.08.2017 (Annexure P-1).

4. Without adverting to merits of the petitioner's allegations, the matter is disposed off with a direction upon respondent No. 2 to take cognizance of the petitioner's aforesaid representation and ensure that adequate notice under Section 160(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure is given to him in the event of any criminal complaint being actually filed against him, and to ensure that he is not subjected to any unnecessary harassment.
