By way of this order, I shall dispose of aforesaid petitions as identical questions of law and fact are involved for adjudication.

After arguing for sometime, when counsel for respondent No. 2 apprised the Court that the charges were framed in the year 2013 and material witnesses in the case have been examined, counsel for the petitioners states that the instant petitions may be dismissed as withdrawn but personal appearance of the petitioners may be exempted.

Counsel for respondent No. 2 has got no objection.

In view of the above, the petitions are disposed of. Personal appearance of the petitioners shall remain exempted before the trial Court but subject to the following conditions:-

- 1) the petitioners shall ensure that they are represented before the Court through counsel;
- 2) they will not raise any question qua their identity for want of personal appearance; and
- 3) they shall appear before the trial Court as and when called upon for progress of the trial.
