Petitioner-Jaswinder Singh @ Jassa has filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.142 dated 20.06.2011, registered at Police Station Adampur, District Jalandhar, under Sections 336 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and have gone through the record.

From the record, I find that the petitioner absented from the court proceedings and was ultimately declared proclaimed offender by the trial Court.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case and in view of the facts that he remained absent from the court proceedings and has been declared as proclaimed offender, I do not find it a fit case where the petitioner is entitled to the benefit of anticipatory bail.

Therefore, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.
