On 09.02.2017, following order was passed by this
Court:-

*“Learned counsel for the petitioner contends
that the enquiry conducted by the Committee
comprising of the Additional Deputy Commissioner,
Assistant Commissioner and S.D.O. (Electricity)
has been considered by the Deputy Commissioner
and nothing incriminating was found against the
employees of the Department.*

*In the meanwhile, petitioner is directed to
appear before the SHO/Investigating Officer to join*

investigation on 15.02.2017 and submit an inventory of the record which has been burnt. In the event of arrest of the petitioner, he shall be enlarged on ad interim bail, subject to the satisfaction of Arresting Officer. However, petitioner shall abide by the conditions incorporated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

It is made clear that the aforesaid arrangement is for one date subject to further extension by this Court.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that in pursuance of aforesaid order, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

This fact has not been disputed by learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Som Nath, Vigilance Bureau, Tarn Taran and further stated that he is no more required in further investigation of the case.

In view of above, order dated 09.02.2017 is hereby made absolute.
