Petitioner-Saurav has filed this petition under Section 438 read with Section 482 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.52 dated 02.04.2017, registered at Police Station Women, District Faridabad, under Sections 366-A IPC, Section 6 of POCSO Act and Section 3 of the SC & ST Act, 1989.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and have gone through the record.

From the record, I find that FIR, in the present case, has been registered on the statement of prosecutrix, who is aged about 16 years and studying in 9th class. As per the FIR, gang rape has been committed upon the prosecutrix.

Keeping in view the serious nature and gravity of the offence, I do not find it a fit case where the petitioner is entitled to the benefit of anticipatory bail.

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Therefore, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.
