Through this petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, prayer has been made for quashing F.I.R. No.83 dated 16.06.2015 registered under Sections 452, 427, 324, 323, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code (Sections 325 and 326 IPC added vide DDR No.14 dated 22.06.2015), at Police Station Ajnala, District Amritsar Rural, Amritsar, on the basis of compromise dated 27.07.2017 (Annexure-P2).

On presentation of the petition, vide order dated 22.09.2017 passed by a co-ordinate Bench of this Court, the parties were directed to appear before the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate for recording their statements with a direction to the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate to furnish a report qua veracity thereof, if any, between the parties.

Consequently, the parties had appeared before the Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Ajnala on 13.10.2017 and got recorded their statements. Report from the concerned Magistrate has been received vide covering letter No.476 dated 25.10.2017 duly forwarded by learned District and Sessions Judge, Amritsar vide Endorsement No.9795R dated 27.10.2017.

According to the report of Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Ajnala, the compromise has been effected between the complainant and the accused parties without any threat, coercion or undue influence.

In view of the totality of the facts and circumstances and considering the fact that the compromise will bring harmony in relations between the parties, the present petition is accepted and the aforesaid F.I.R. No.83, is quashed qua the petitioners.
