Prayer in this petition is for quashing of the order dated 08.10.2016, passed by respondent No.2.

The petitioner, on an earlier occasion, has filed CRM-M-22983-2016 praying for issuance of direction to respondent No.2-the Superintendent of Police, Hisar, to decide his representation.

This Court, vide order dated 12.07.2016, directed to respondent No.2-Superintendent of Police, Hisar to decide the representation of the petitioner dated 04.01.2016 and in pursuance, thereof, the impugned order dated 08.10.2016 has been passed by the Superintendent of Police, Hisar.

A perusal of this order shows that the Superintendent of Police, Hisar has observed that the dispute between the parties is purely in civil nature and no cognizable offence is made out. Accordingly, the representation was ordered to be filed being devoid of merit.

This petition has been filed after about one year of passing of the order and without explaining the delay, no ground for interference is made out.

Dismissed.
