Quashing of FIR No. 78 dated 4.9.2016 under Sections 354-A, 452, 506 of IPC registered at Women Police Station, District Ambala is being sought on the basis of compromise deed dated 27.9.2016 (Annexure P-2).

As per allegations in the FIR, respondent No. 2 was alone at her home. Her husband had gone outside. At that time, her neighbour-Kuldeep Singh @ Bhana came to her house to get food. She told him that food is not ready and he may come later. But Kuldeep Singh tried to outrage modesty of respondent No. 2. On this background, FIR was got registered.

However, the matter has now been duly compromised. In compliance of order dated 17.10.2016, report dated 18.1.2017 of Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Ambala has been received in this regard. As per report, statement of parties have been recorded. Complainant-respondent No.2 stated that the matter stands compromised between the parties and she does not want to proceed further against the accused and has no objection, if the present F.I.R be quashed against the petitioner. The compromise has been entered voluntarily. To the same effect is the statements given by petitioner.

Consequently, in view of the status report dated 18.1.2017 and in view of the judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the case of ***Dr. Arvind Barsaul etc. versus State of Madhya Pradesh and another 2008(2) RCR (Criminal) 910***, no useful purpose would be served in prolonging the litigation.

Accordingly, FIR No. 78 dated 4.9.2016 under Sections 354-A, 452, 506 of IPC registered at Women Police Station, District Ambala, is quashed along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom qua petitioner.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
