Petitioners-Surjit Singh and Arjinder Singh have filed the petition seeking quashing of FIR No.101 dated 21.5.2010 under Sections 452, 324, 341, 427, 148 and 149 of IPC registered at Police Station City Phagwara District Kapurthala at the instance of respondent No.2 Rupinder Singh. Quashing is sought on the basis of a compromise having been effected between the parties.

Vide order dated 25.9.2017 the parties had been directed to appear before the trial Court to get their statements recorded regarding the compromise.

Report of the trial Court has been received along with statement of complainant-Rupinder Singh. As per the statement and report, the parties have effected a compromise voluntarily and without any coercion or undue

influence. The petitioner as well as the complainant are residents of Phagwara, District Kapurthala. It will certainly promote harmony and cordial relations amongst the parties, if criminal proceedings are dropped.

In view of the above stated position, especially the fact that a compromise has been effected between the parties, FIR No.101 dated 21.5.2010 under Sections 452, 324, 341, 427, 148 and 149 of IPC registered at Police Station City Phagwara District Kapurthala and all subsequent proceedings arising out of the same are hereby quashed.
