Petitioner-Aman Verma has filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for brevity, 'Cr.P.C.') for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.82 dated 15.09.2016, registered at Police Station Fattu DHINGA, District Kapurthala, under Section 420 of the Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion was issued in this case. Learned State counsel put in appearance on behalf of respondent No.1-State and contested the instant petition.

Respondent No.2-complainant also appeared through his counsel.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

Learned counsel for respondent No.2 submits that compromise has already been effected between the parties.

In pursuance of the interim order dated 25.09.2017 passed by this Court, the petitioner has already joined the investigation. He is not required for custodial interrogation. Therefore, no useful purpose will be served by sending him to custody.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts of the case in minute details and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, I find merit in this petition and the same is allowed. The order dated 25.09.2017, granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions of Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
