Prayer in the instant petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure has been made for quashing of F.I.R. No.506 dated 11.09.2013 under Sections 323/294/34 I.P.C. pertaining to Police Station Sadar, Bahadurgarh, on the basis of compromise dated 19.01.2017 (Annexure-P3).

Vide order dated 01.03.2017 passed by this Court, both the parties were directed to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate to get their statements recorded for compromise with a direction to the Illaqa Magistrate to furnish a report alongwith the recorded statements qua veracity of the compromise, if any, between the parties.

In compliance to the order dated 01.03.2017 of this Court, the

parties had appeared before the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Bahadurgarh

on 25.04.2017 and got recorded their statements for compromise and report from the concerned Magistrate has also been received vide his covering letter No.713 dated 27.07.2017 duly forwarded by learned District and Sessions Judge, Jhajjar vide letter No.14054 dated 29.07.2017.

According to the report of Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Bahadurgarh, the compromise between the parties is genuine and not the result of any pressure or coercion from any corner.

In view of the totality of the facts and circumstances and considering the fact that the compromise will bring harmony in relations between the parties, the aforesaid F.I.R. No.506, is hereby quashed.

Petition is disposed of accordingly.
