The petitioners are seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 144 dated 23.08.2017, under Sections 379, 411 IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Hoshiarpur, District Hoshiarpur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioners are not named in the FIR which has been registered against unknown persons for the theft of two buffaloes. The petitioners have been arraigned as accused on the disclosure statement of co-accused Gurmeet Singh. He further states that the petitioners are not involved in any other case.

This Court vide order dated 25.09.2017, had directed the petitioners to appear before the trial Court and in the event of their arrest, they were to be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

Learned State counsel upon instructions from ASI Vijay

Kumar states that in pursuance to the order dated 25.09.2017 the petitioners have joined investigation and are not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above and without expressing any opinion on the merits of case, the order dated 25.09.2017, granting ad-interim bail to the petitioners, is hereby made absolute. However, the petitioners shall abide by the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
