Counsel for the petitioner has expressed inability of the petitioner to pay an amount of Rs.20,000/- to the respondent in compliance with order dated 30.11.2016 passed by this Court. On a pointed query raised by the Court, counsel for the petitioner has fairly informed that the petitioner even failed to pay an amount of Rs.10,000/- to the respondent in compliance with order dated 05.11.2015. A relevant extract from order dated 05.11.2015, 16.05.2016 and 30.11.2016 passed by this Court reads as follows:-

“Order dated 05.11.2015

Notice of motion to the respondent for appearing before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of Punjab and Haryana High Court on December 2, 2015. Petitioner will also appear before the Mediator and pay a sum of Rs.10000/- to the respondent on said date before the Mediator for enabling her to meet the travelling and other misc. expenses.

Order dated 16.05.2016

Counsel for the respondent states that the petitioner has not paid the amount of Rs.10,000/- which was ordered to be paid by this Court vide order dated 5.11.2015.

There is a request for adjournment on behalf of counsel for the petitioner.

Adjourned to 23.9.2016.

Let the amount be paid to the respondent before the next date.

Order dated 30.11.2016

The petitioner had been asked to deposit Rs.10,000/- on 05.11.2015. Neither the amount was paid nor deposited. This fact was brought to the notice of this court in May, 2016. The amount still has not been paid.

Adjourned to 27.02.2017.

Petitioner would pay Rs.20,000/- as travelling and misc. expenses to the respondent on or before the next date of hearing.”

In view of the above, the petitioner has disentitled himself to be heard on merits of the case for his failure to comply with orders of this Court.

Dismissed.
