ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioners are seeking quashing of FIR No.0123 dated 14.08.2017 under Sections 406,420,506,120-B IPC registered at Police Station Kalka, District Panchkula, on the basis of compromise dated 30.08.2017 (Annexure P-2) arrived at between the parties.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that FIR is an outcome of a monetary dispute between the parties and the matter has now been resolved.

This Court by the order dated 31.10.2017 had directed the parties to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court for recording their statements with regard to veracity of the compromise. The Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Kalka, has sent his report dated 15.11.2017, wherein it is stated that in pursuance to the order of this Court, statements of the parties were recorded. As

per the statements, compromise has been effected without any fear or undue influence.

The FIR is an outcome of a monetary dispute between the parties and the matter has now been resolved.

In view of the law laid down in "**Narinder Singh Vs. State of Punjab**" **2014 (6) SCC 466**, no useful purpose will be served by continuing the criminal proceedings. Therefore, the petition is allowed and FIR No.0123 dated 14.08.2017 under Sections 406,420,506,120-B IPC registered at Police Station Kalka, District Panchkula and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, are hereby quashed qua the petitioners only.
