Petitioner seeks the benefit of regular bail, pending trial,
in case FIR No.7 dated 10.01.2017, under Section 20/61/85 of ND
& PS Act, registered at Police Station Dugri, District Ludhiana.

As per prosecution version, the alleged recovery of 400
grams of *Charas* was recovered from the possession of the
petitioner.

The said recovery would be construed as non-
commercial.

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The matter is still at the stage of investigation. Yet it has gone uncontroverted that the petitioner is not involved in any other case under NDPS Act.

Petitioner is in custody since 10.01.2017.

Without making any observations on merits, the present petition is allowed.

Petitioner be enlarged on bail subject to the satisfaction of the CJM/Duty Magistrate, Ludhiana.
