The instant petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking regular bail in case F.I.R. No. 78, dated 24.03.2017, registered under Sections 420, 467, 468 and 471 of the Indian Penal Code, at Police Station Julana, District Jind.

2. It is contended by Ld. Counsel for the petitioner, *inter alia*, that the petitioner was not originally named in the F.I.R. He has remained in detention for over a month and a half now, since 11.08.2017. No recovery from him has been effected and the only incriminating material against him is the statement of a co-accused.

3. In the given circumstances, at this stage, the present petition is

allowed and the petitioner, namely Sumit Kumar son of Samar Singh, is directed to be released on regular bail subject to appropriate terms and conditions to the satisfaction of the Ld. Chief Judicial Magistrate/Area Magistrate concerned.
