INDERJIT SINGH, J.

Petitioner-Gajender Singh has filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.281 dated 26.09.2016, registered at Police Station City Rewari, under Sections 420 and 406 of the Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion was issued in this case. Learned State counsel put in appearance on behalf of respondent-State and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

From the record, I find that allegation against the present petitioner is that he has taken the amount of Rs.5 lakhs approximately from

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the students. It is argued by learned State counsel that less than Rs.1 lakh has been deposited with the University and the degrees, which are stated to have been given by the present petitioner, are found to be fake. The petitioner is required for custodial interrogation.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case and in view of serious allegations against the present petitioner, I do not find it a fit case where the petitioner is entitled to the benefit of anticipatory bail.

Therefore, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.
