ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.61 dated 27.05.2017 under Sections 307/323/324/148/149 IPC and Section 27 of the Arms Act, registered at Police Station Rahon, District S.B.S. Nagar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that allegations against the petitioner are that he had fired two gun shots which had injured five persons. He further states that he himself had sustained serious head injuries and has referred to the medico-legal report as well as medical opinion in this regard. He further contends that the petitioner is in custody for over 04 months ever since the date of his arrest on 30.05.2017.

Learned counsel further contends that all the injured have fully recovered from their injuries.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Balwinder Singh, states that injury caused by the petitioner on the chest of Manmohan Kaur was found to be dangerous to life. He also contends that investigation has been completed, challan has been filed in Court but charges are yet to be framed.

Heard learned counsel for the parties.

The petitioner is stated to have sustained serious injuries. The injuries sustained by him and as reflected in the MLR, are reproduced hereunder :-

"i) CLW (4.5cm x ½ x ½ cm) present over the occipital parietal region of head fresh bleeding present from the wound longitudinal in direction.

ii) Multiple abrasions, swelling, oozing of blood present over the outer aspect of upper 1/3 of left forearm and elbow."

In the certificate issued by Senior Medical Officer, Central Jail, Ludhiana on 06.07.2017, a copy whereof is annexed as Annexure P-2, it is mentioned that CT scan of the head of petitioner showed scalp odema with lacerated wound right high parietal region.

All the injured are stated to have been fully recovered. The investigation has been completed. Charges are yet to be framed. The conclusion of trial is likely to take some time. In

these circumstances and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. Petitioner Mohabbat Pal Singh is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
