The present petition has been filed impugning the order dated 4.12.2008, whereby the conviction of the petitioner for having committed an offence punishable under Section 407 IPC recorded by learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Tarn Taran vide order dated 17.8.2005 was upheld in appeal. However, the sentence of imprisonment of the petitioner was reduced from two years' rigorous imprisonment to one year rigorous imprisonment.

During the pendency of the present petition, the sentence awarded to the petitioner was suspended.

Learned counsel for the State submitted that as per the information received from Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran, the petitioner has expired.

Considering the aforesaid factual matrix, in my view, the present petition has abated. Ordered accordingly.
