Through the instant petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C., the petitioner has challenged the order dated 30.10.2014 passed by Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Karnal, whereby the complaint filed by the petitioner-complainant was dismissed. Challenge has also been laid to order dated 07.08.2015 passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Karnal, whereby the revision petition against the order dated 30.10.2014 was dismissed.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

The petitioner has not only failed to deposit the costs, rather evidence in support of the complaint has also not been adduced by the petitioner despite availing various opportunities. Even on the date when the impugned order dated 30.10.2014 was passed, the petitioner failed to

deposit the costs and the case was repeatedly adjourned at the behest of the petitioner on one pretext or the other. On 24.02.2014, last opportunity was granted to the petitioner to examine his witnesses, which was further extended to 14.05.2014. Thereafter again, last opportunity was extended on 16.8.2014 and in this manner, the petitioner has not adduced any evidence in support of the complaint.

In this view of the matter, this Court finds no illegality in the impugned order dated 30.10.2014 passed by Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Karnal and order dated 7.8.2015 passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Karnal.

Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed.
