Counsel for the petitioner would submit that the petitioner has already joined investigation in compliance with order dated 18.10.2016 passed by this Court and is ready to face proceedings, in accordance with law. It is further submitted that even as per the list submitted by the complainant, correctness whereof would be subject matter of trial, the complainant was given one gold set towards her stridhan, one gold chain and pair of tops at the time of birth of the child. It is further submitted that it is difficult to accept that the girl left those articles of gold at the matrimonial home while leaving the matrimonial home. It is further submitted that even the complainant has not appeared in this Court to say something in the matter with regard to the petitioner being in possession of any articles of stridhan.

Counsel for the State concedes to the position that the

petitioner has already joined investigation but it is submitted that gold articles have not been recovered.

In view of the above, interim bail granted to the petitioner is made absolute. However, he shall abide by the following conditions:-

- (i) He shall join the investigation as and when required by the Investigating Officer.
- (ii) He shall not offer any threat, promise or inducement to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing the same to the Investigating Officer/Court; and
- (iii) He shall not leave the limits of this country without prior permission of the Court.

Petition stands disposed of.
