The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 104 dated 02.09.2017, under Section 15 of NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Kotbhai, District Sri Muktsar Sahib.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations against the petitioner in the FIR are that 6 kg 400 grams of poppy husk was recovered from his house. She further states that the FIR was registered on the basis of secret information and the petitioner was admitted in Government Hospital, Muktsar from 01.09.2017 to 05.09.2017 as he had sustained serious injuries in an accident for which he had lodged an FIR. She has referred to the medical record of the petitioner, which is appended as Annexure P-2(Colly).

This Court vide order dated 27.09.2017, had directed the petitioner to appear before the trial Court and on his doing so,

he was to be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

Learned State counsel upon instructions from HC Jasbir Singh states that in pursuance to the order dated 27.09.2017 the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above and without expressing any opinion on the merits of case, the order dated 27.09.2017, granting ad-interim bail to the petitioner, is hereby made absolute. However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
