By filing the present petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioners seek quashing of FIR No. 24 dated 30.06.2011, registered under Sections 498-A and 406 of IPC, at Police Station Women Cell, Jalandhar, District Jalandhar.

The learned counsel for the petitioners does not press the present petition for quashing as it suffers with certain errors and seeks liberty to file afresh with better particulars.

Prayer allowed.

The learned counsel for the petitioners refers to Annexure P-3 to contend that a compromise has been reached between the parties. Even petitioner No.3 went abroad on 12.05.2010 much prior to passing of order dated 04.1.2013, whereby he has been

declared as a proclaimed offender.

Notice of motion.

At the asking of the Court, Mr. A.S. Gill, Sr. DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State. A complete copy of the paper book has been furnished to the learned State counsel, in the Court.

Heard.

Keeping in view the factum of compromise, it is ordered that in case petitioner No.3 appears/surrenders before the trial Court within 10 days from today, in that eventuality, he shall be admitted to bail on his furnishing fresh bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
