Petitioner-Gurmeet Kaur has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.121 dated 28.08.2016, registered at Police Station Machhiwara, Ludhiana, under Sections 302, 323, 324, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion has been issued. Learned State counsel has appeared and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

From the record, I find that as per the allegations, the present petitioner has only raised *lalkara* and she has not caused any injury to any person.

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The petitioner has been in custody since 29.08.2016. She is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as she is in judicial custody. The trial of the case will take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Moreover, co-accused namely Bachan Kaur and Balwinder Singh @ Baljinder Singh have already been granted the benefit of bail and, therefore, the petitioner is entitled to bail on the ground of parity also.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to her furnishing personal bonds in the sum of ₹50,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
