CRM-M No.36135 of 2017

The instant petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (for short, 'the Cr.P.C.') seeking regular bail on behalf of the petitioner in case FIR No.400 dated 23rd June, 2017, registered under Sections 147, 148, 149, 323, 324, 341, 506 of the Indian Penal Code (for short, 'the IPC') and Section 326 of the IPC at Police Station Hansi City, District Hisar.

It has been contended that the petitioner has remained in detention for over two months now, since 28th of July, 2017

From the available material, it transpires that the petitioner's role was limited to causing a simple injury to the complainant with a blunt weapon. The grievous injury caused to the other victim is not attributable to the petitioner.

As such, the present petitioner, namely Om Parkash, may be released on regular bail to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court/Area Magistrate concerned.
