The instant petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking regular bail on behalf of the petitioner in case FIR No.1110 dated 6th December, 2016, registered under Sections 323, 506 and 307 (added later on) read with Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code, at Police Station City Ballabgarh, District Faridabad.

It is contended *inter alia* that the petitioner has remained in detention for over six months now. There was a delay of three days in lodging the FIR and Ld. Counsel for the petitioner has drawn attention of the Court to the original MLR of the victim (Annexure P-2) which initially did not disclose any grievous injury on the relevant date.

Other co-accused persons have been granted bail after completion of investigation.

In the given circumstances, further detention of the petitioner-Sagar for an indefinite period is not justified. He may, therefore, be released on bail to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court/Area Magistrate concerned.
