ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.258 dated 29.10.2015, under Sections 323, 342, 365, 379, 500, 148, 149 of IPC, registered at Police Station City Kapurthala, District Kapurthala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that although the occurrence is stated to have taken place on 29.07.2015 but the FIR was lodged after three months on 29.10.2015. He further states that no injury was caused to the complainant who as per his version in the FIR was released on the date of the incident itself.

This Court, by the order dated 27.09.2017, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting

Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Bhagwant Singh, states that although the petitioner has joined investigation but he is not disclosing the whereabouts of the other accused.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner and keeping in view the fact that the petitioner has joined investigation, the order dated 27.09.2017 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
