The petitioners are seeking quashing of Rapat No.29 dated 27.03.2016 under Sections 323, 324, 325, 342, 34 of IPC registered in FIR No.41 dated 25.03.2016 under Sections 452, 323, 325, 427, 148, 149 of IPC, registered at Police Station B Division, Amritsar, on the basis of compromise/affidavit dated 05.04.2016 (Annexure P-3), which has been arrived at between the parties.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the incident is an outcome of a matrimonial dispute between the parties, which has now been resolved. The respondents have also filed petition for quashing the FIR. Learned counsel also contends that all the injuries are simple in nature except one injury on the right hand of the injured.

This Court by the order dated 03.11.2017 had directed the parties to appear before the trial Court to record the

statements of the parties with regard to genuineness of the compromise and send a report to this Court. The report of JMIC, Amritsar, dated 20.11.2017 has been received, wherein it is stated that in pursuance to the order of this Court, the statements of the parties were recorded which indicates that the compromise is genuine, without any coercion or undue influence.

The incident is an outcome of a matrimonial dispute between the parties, which has now been resolved.

In view of the mandate of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the case of **Narinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and another, (2014) 6 SCC 466**, no useful purpose will be served by continuing the criminal proceedings. Therefore, the petition is allowed and Rapat No.29 dated 27.03.2016 under Sections 323, 324, 325, 342, 34 of IPC registered in FIR No.41 dated 25.03.2016 under Sections 452, 323, 325, 427, 148, 149 of IPC, registered at Police Station B Division, Amritsar and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, are hereby quashed qua the petitioner(s).
