ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking quashing of FIR No.102 dated 06.05.2017 under Sections 323/341 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, registered at Police Station Nathana, District Bathinda (Annexure P-1), on the basis of compromise dated 08.05.2017 (Annexure P-2) arrived at between the parties.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that FIR is an outcome of a sudden altercation between the residents of same village. No injuries were caused in the occurrence and the matter has now been compromised.

This Court by the order dated 27.09.2017, had directed the parties to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court for recording their statements with regard to veracity of

the compromise. The Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Bathinda, has sent his report dated 26.10.2017, wherein it is stated that in pursuance to the order of this Court, statements of the parties were recorded. As per the statements, compromise has been effected without any fear or undue influence.

The FIR is an outcome of a sudden altercation between the parties, which has now been resolved.

In view of the law laid down in "**Narinder Singh Vs. State of Punjab**" 2014 (6) SCC 466, no useful purpose will be served by continuing the criminal proceedings. Therefore, the petition is allowed and FIR No.102 dated 06.05.2017 under Sections 323/341 IPC and Section 25 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station Nathana, District Bathinda and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, are hereby quashed qua the petitioner only.
