Notice sent to respondent No. 2 has been received back duly served but there is no representation on her behalf.

Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in pursuance of interim bail granted by this court vide order dated 19.10.2016, the petitioner has already joined investigation and he is ready to face proceedings, in accordance with law.

Counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Chranji Lal concedes to the position that the petitioner has joined investigation and states that two rings and one chain (gold) given to the petitioner are yet to be recovered. It is further submitted that cooler and fridge also remained to be recovered,.

I have heard counsel for the parties and perused the paper book.

It is not the allegation that two rings and chain (gold) given to the husband constitute *stridhan* of the complainant. The complainant has not appeared despite service in order to say something with regard to non recovery of articles of *stridhan*.

In view of the above, interim bail granted to the petitioner is made absolute subject to the following conditions:-

- (i) He shall Join the investigation as and when required by the Investigating Officer.
- (ii) He shall not offer any threat, promise or inducement to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing the same to the Investigating Officer/Court; and
- (iii) He shall not leave the limits of this country without prior permission of the Court.
