Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 625 dated 02.08.2017 registered under Sections 15/27-A/29/61/85 of the NDPS Act.

Counsel for the petitioner states that on the basis of the statement of co-accused Trilok, the name of the petitioner has figured in the case but till date no recovery has been effected from the possession of the petitioner.

On the other hand, learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Shamsheer Singh, submits that apart from this case, the petitioner is also an accused in FIR No. 617 dated 30.07.2017 though in which he has been admitted to bail.

In view of the fact that the petitioner is involve in another case, no ground is made out to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.
