Counsel for the petitioners has submitted that the petitioners have already joined investigation and are ready to face proceedings, in accordance with law.

As per stand of counsel for the State, on instructions from HC Jaswant Singh, the petitioners have been declared innocent in the enquiry conducted by the Deputy Superintendent of Police, Bathinda.

In view of the above, interim bail granted to the petitioners is made absolute subject to the following conditions:-

- (i) They shall join the investigation as and when required by the Investigating Officer.
- (ii) They shall not offer any threat, promise or inducement to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as

to dissuade him from disclosing the same to the Investigating Officer/Court; and

(iii) They shall not leave the limits of this country without prior permission of the Court.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
