By filing the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought anticipatory bail in FIR No.39 dated 24.03.2016, registered under Sections 452, 325, 324, 323, 427 and 148 read with Section 149 of Indian Penal Code at Police Station Beas, District Amritsar.

On 20.10.2016, this Court had passed the following order:-

“Learned counsel refers to Annexure P-2 MLR of the petitioner and Annexure P-4 MLR of his sister, namely, Reena who has received 04 injuries including the grievous injury. Learned counsel further contends that the injury attributed to the petitioner is simple in nature.

Notice of motion for 14.12.2016.

Meanwhile, in the event of arrest of the petitioner by the Arresting Officer, he shall be released on interim bail subject to the following conditions:-

- 1.That he shall make himself available for interrogation by a police officer as and when required;
- 2.That he shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the

case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer and;

3. That he shall not leave India without prior permission of the Court.”

It is contended that in pursuance of the order dated 20.10.2016 the petitioner has joined the investigation. The learned State counsel, submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 20.10.2016, is made absolute, subject to furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, concerned.

The petition stands allowed.
