Prayer in the instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been made for issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 3 to conduct an enquiry/investigation and initiate appropriate criminal proceedings against respondents No.4 to 13.

Heard.

The petitioner has claimed herself to be a tenant of respondent No.4 since last 12 years. She has also filed a criminal complaint against respondent No.4 and others. Perusal of the instant petition shows that petitioner is well conversant with the intricacies of legal procedure. She even got issued directions to the Public Prosecutor from the Court, where her complaint is pending, to inspect the spot of alleged occurrence. Prima facie, it seems that by way of the present petition, the petitioner wants to create evidence of her alleged tenancy over the demised premises. Hence, the instant petition is a clear cut abuse of the process of the Court and is dismissed as such.
