By filing the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought anticipatory bail in a case FIR No.81, dated 14.09.2016, registered under Sections 458, 324, 427 and 148 of the Indian Penal Code (for short 'the IPC') read with Section 149 IPC, at Police Station Sherpur, District Sangrur.

The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner contends that in pursuance of the order dated 08.11.2016, the petitioner has joined the investigation. He further states that co-accused have already been admitted to bail.

The learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that in pursuance of the order passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the

investigation and he is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 08.11.2016, is made absolute, subject to furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, concerned.

The petition stands allowed.
