This order shall dispose of the instant petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.80, dated 15.09.2016, under Section 306 IPC, registered at Police Station Balongi, District SAS Nagar.

On 16.11.2016, while granting interim protection to the petitioner, the following order was passed by this Court.

“Inter-alia, it has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that there is no instigation or abetment on the part of the petitioner which allegedly drove the petitioner to commit the suicide. Even otherwise, there is documentary evidence available on the file that the salary has already been paid to the deceased by the petitioner for the period he worked.

List on 03.02.2017.

In the meanwhile, petitioner is directed to join the investigation within a period of seven days from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. In the event of arrest, petitioner shall be released on interim bail at the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer/Investigating Officer subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned State counsel upon instructions from ASI Ashok Kumar would apprise the Court that the petitioner has since joined investigation.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed. Order dated 16.11.2016 passed by this Court is made absolute.
