This petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.58 dated 11.09.2016, under Sections 406, 498-A & 506 IPC, registered at Women Police Station, Panchkula, District Panchkula (Haryana).

With the assistance of Mr. Sachin Jain, Advocate/Mediator, an attempt was made for an amicable settlement between the parties. It seems that respondent No.2 wants to go with the petitioner in her matrimonial home, which is not accepted by the petitioner. No mediation is possible in this case.

In view of the said fact, interim order dated 21.10.2016 passed by

two months, the petitioner will get an FD of Rs.2,00,000/- in the name of the complainant and deposit the same before the trial Court. Fate of the said FD shall be decided by the trial Court at the final stage of the trial. This amount can be taken into consideration, if an amicable settlement is arrived at between the parties.

Disposed of accordingly.
