Prayer in this petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.144 dated 08.07.2017 under Sections 27, 29 of Wild Life (Protection) Act, 1972 and Sections 307, 353, 186, 379 IPC, registered at Police Station Chhachhrauli, District Yamuna Nagar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner has not been named in the FIR and he has been arrayed as an accused only on the basis of some information from a secret informer, who has not been able to identify the petitioner correctly during night time.

On the other hand, learned State counsel states that the petitioner has been identified by the Secret Informer and the allegation against the petitioner are otherwise serious in nature. The Secret

Informer has identified the accused i.e. the present petitioner as well as the other co-accused Jamshed. The petitioner was in a canter from which recovery of khair wood was effected.

Since the allegations against the petitioner are serious in nature, no case for grant of regular bail is made out. Accordingly, present petition is dismissed.

The observations made hereinabove shall not be construed as an expression on the merits of the case and the trial court shall decide the case on the basis of available material.
