Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

This is a petition seeking regular bail in FIR No.05 dated 05.01.2016, under Sections 22, 25 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substance Act, 1985, registered at Police Station Bareta, District Mansa. Petitioner was arrested on 05.01.2016.

According to the prosecution, when the petitioner was arrested, 70 bottles of rexcof were recovered and only 2 bottles were sent for FSL examination. There is no other case pending against the petitioner. Out of 8 witnesses, 2 have been examined. In that view of the matter, petitioner is entitled to grant bail.

In that view of the matter, this petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned. Petitioner shall not tamper with the prosecution evidence, threaten or exercise any influence on the prosecution witnesses.
