Learned State counsel submits that the offence punishable under Section 304A IPC was converted into one under Section 304 IPC after it was found that the petitioner was under the influence of alcohol while driving, leading to the accident in which 5 people are stated to have died.

Hence, without commenting upon the actual merits of the case, I do not find it to be a fit case where the concession of regular bail can be granted at this stage at least.

Accordingly, the petition is dismissed.
