DEEPAK SIBAL J. (ORAL)

Through the present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., the petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.744, dated 24.09.2011, registered under Sections 341, 281, 147 and 149 IPC, at Police Station City Sirsa, District Sirsa.

Vide order of this Court dated 07.02.2017, while issuing notice of motion, the petitioner was directed to appear before the trial Court on 13.02.2017 and on such appearance, he was directed to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

Learned State counsel does not dispute that only on account of the petitioner's non-appearance before the trial Court on 08.07.2016, bail granted to him earlier was cancelled and arrest warrants against him were issued. He, on instructions from SI Nihal Singh, further submits that in pursuance to the interim order passed by this Court, the petitioner has appeared before the trial Court and on such appearance, has been admitted to regular bail to its satisfaction.

In view of the above, the interim order dated 07.02.2017 is ordered to be made absolute with a further direction to the petitioner to appear before the trial Court on each and every date in future unless otherwise exempted by the Court.

If the petitioner is found indulging in any other criminal activity/misusing the concession of bail, it will be open to the State to move an appropriate application before the Competent Court/this Court for cancellation of the granted bail to the petitioner through this order.

The petition stands allowed in the above terms.
