The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C seeking anticipatory bail in Criminal complaint No.55 dated 28.01.2014 titled as “Sunheri Devi vs. Balkar Ram and others” under Sections 304-B and 498-A IPC.

On 28.09.2017, this Court had passed the following order:-

“Learned counsel contends that Balkar Singh, son of petitioner No.1 and husband of the deceased, suffered 60% burn injuries while making efforts of saving the deceased and it was an accidental death. Learned counsel further refers to Annexure P6, Ration Card to contend that the petitioners had been maintaining separate household and did not have any effective connectivity with the deceased and her husband, Balkar Singh.

Notice of motion for 7.11.2017.

Meantime, the petitioners are directed to appear and furnish the bail/ surety bonds before the learned trial Court. On their doing so, they be released on interim bail by learned trial Court. Copy of the order passed by learned trial Court be produced on the next date of hearing. ”

It is contended that in pursuance of the order dated 28.09.2017, the petitioners have appeared before the trial Court and they have been released on interim bail vide orders dated 03.10.2017 and 10.10.2017 which are taken on record as Mark A and B.

In view of above, the order dated 28.09.2017 passed by this Court is made absolute. The petitioners shall continue appearing before the trial Court on each and every date of hearing.

The petition stands allowed.
